Do hereby affirm our commitment to preparing students for lifelong financial well-being by supporting the inclusion of at least one financial literacy instructional touchpoint by the end of 4th and 8th grades through

- Identifying and implementing age-appropriate touchpoints that align with local instructional goals; and

- Incorporating TNFLC-provided resources into classroom instruction; and
- Sharing implementation strategies and outcomes to support continuous improvement and collaboration across the District.
